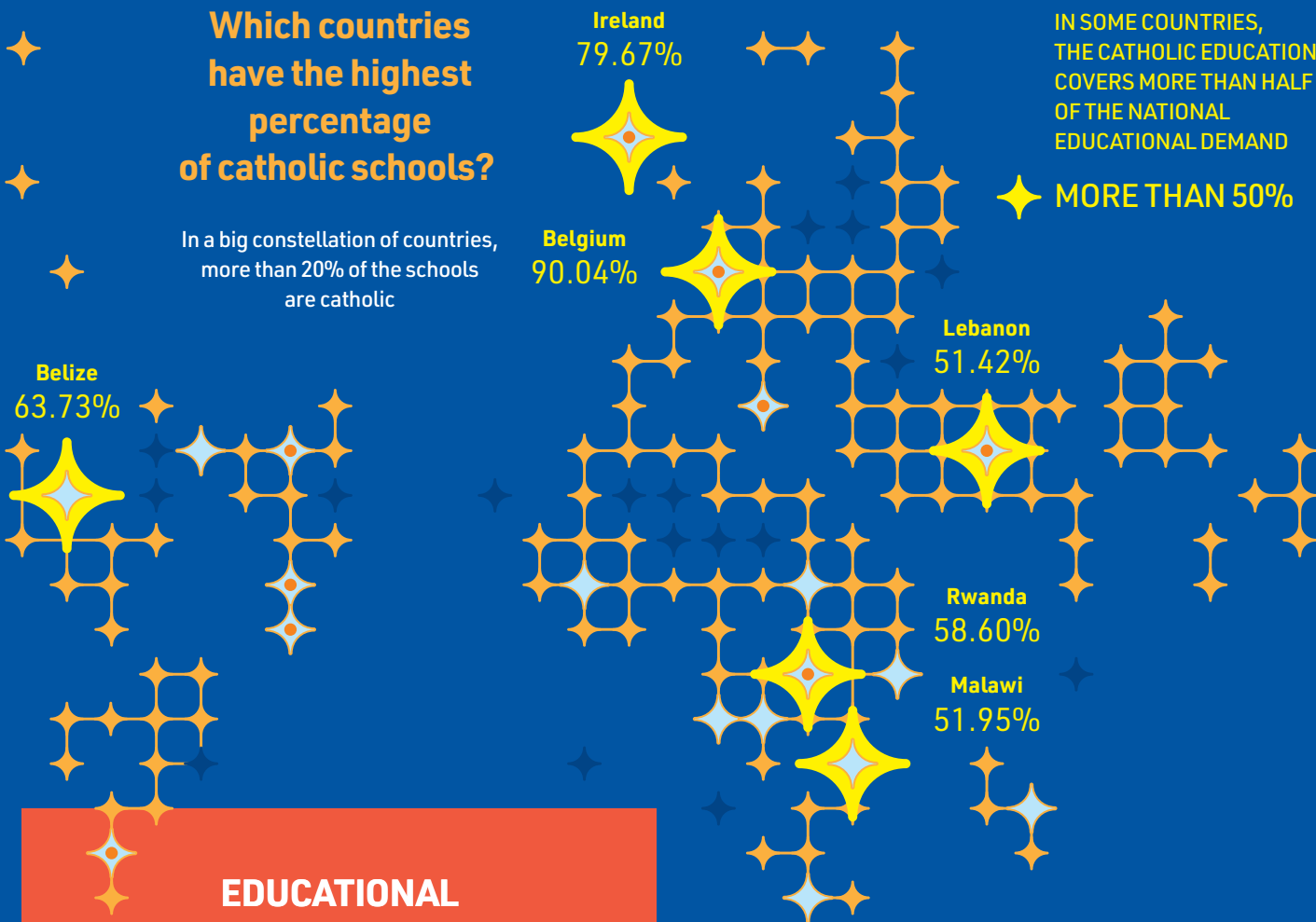


Which countries have the highest percentage of catholic schools?

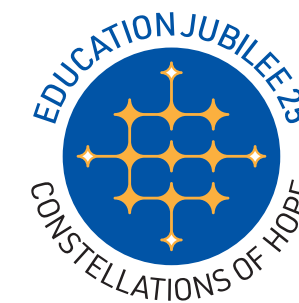

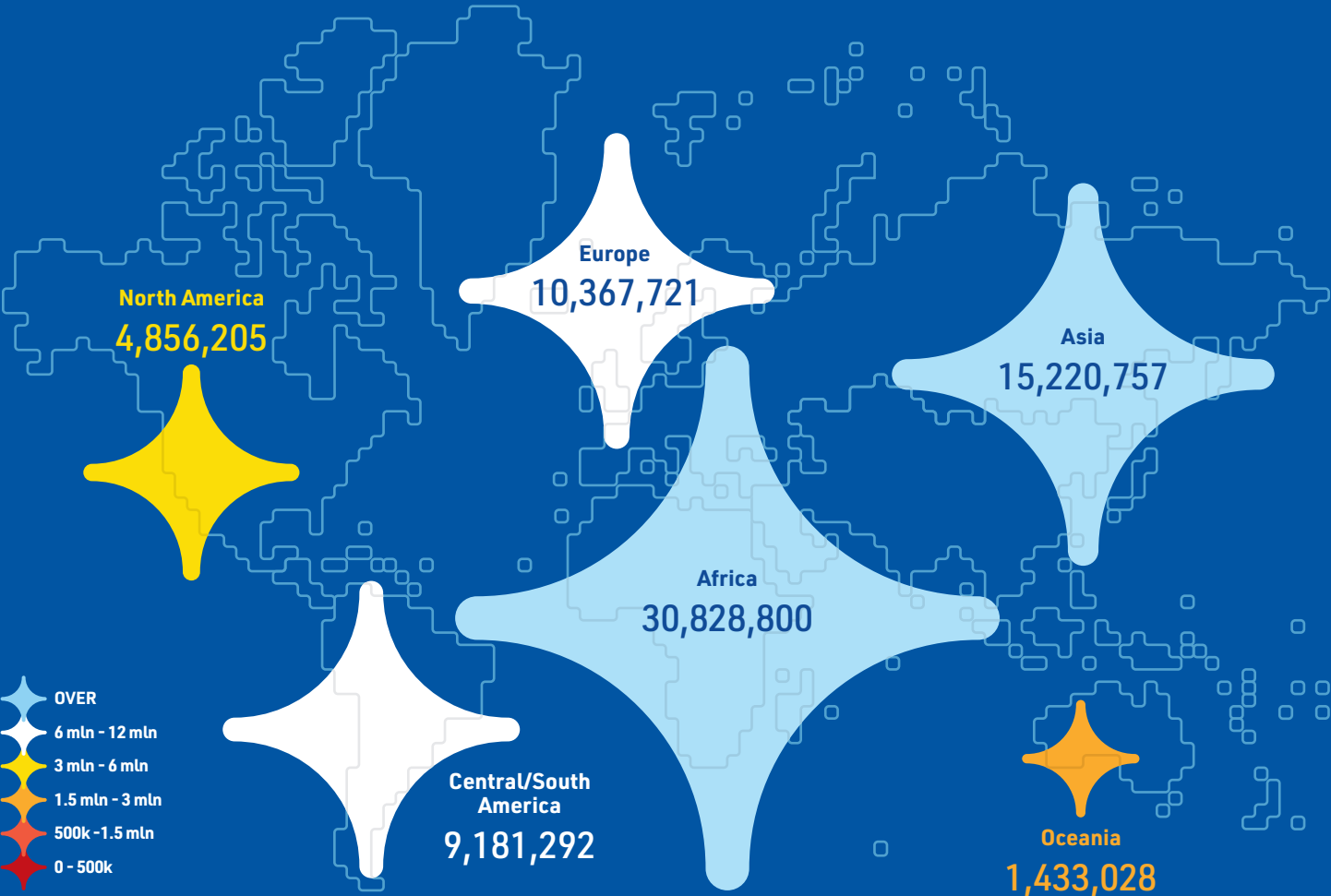

Through its educational network, across all continents, the Church supports younger, who are engaged in building their own life projects in the service of the common good.

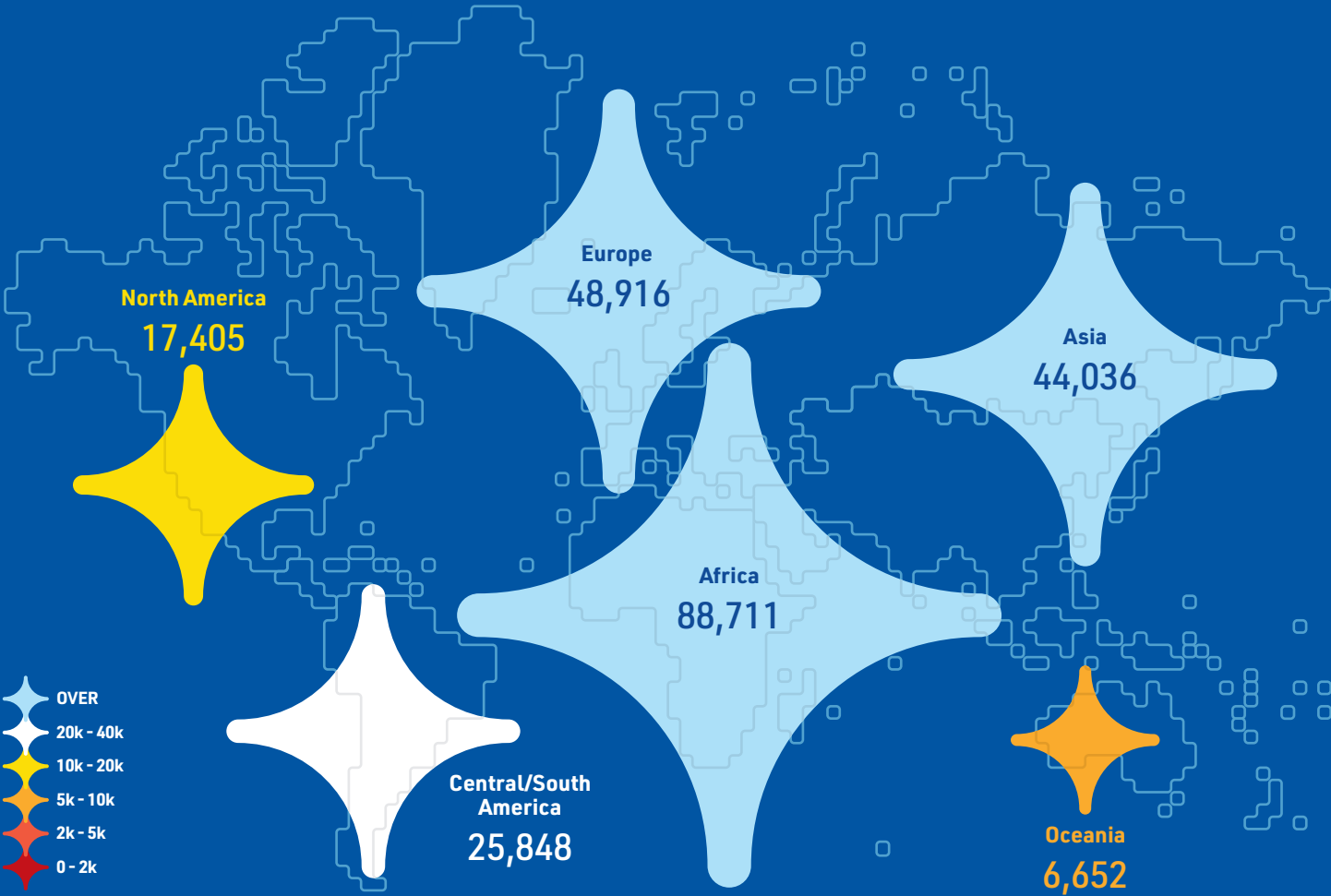
